

## **General Band Booster Board Meeting December 5, 2006**

### **Kelli Dougher-**

Kelli called the meeting to session.

### **Band Directors Report by John Canfield-**

Absent. Nothing new to report.

### **Minutes by Richelle Barnaby-**

October minutes accepted by committee consisting of Kelli Dougher, Cathy Haynes, and Sandra Barnes. Minutes from November meeting were read. No discussion. Minutes amended and accepted.

### **Concessions by Sandra Barnes-**

- Will look to sell the remaining food back to parents or students. Have hotdogs, fries, candy, etc. Sandra to get with Cathy and do an inventory of food left.
- Have 8 cases of hot chocolate left. Suggested using 3 cases (10 gal.) at the holiday ball.

Sandra mentioned that we as parents could suggest to the school administration to have the band keep the same concession stand due to the % of students in the band, cost to run it, and with new location-we will not be able to have the support of the band students.

### **Webmaster Report by Kim Wrick-**

### **Uniform Committee by Marla Davis-**

About 20 uniforms were severely wrinkled when washed thru a particular dryer this last time. One of the dryers was running extremely hot. Marla tried to iron them out, but was not successful. She recommended that we either rent an commercial strength steamer for \$20 or get them done professionally at a drycleaner for approximately \$1.75 per uniform. Discussion was brought up about how to proceed. Sandra made a motion to have someone take one pair to the drycleaner to see if they are able to remove these wrinkles. If it is successful, then we will have the remaining uniforms wrinkled dry-cleaned. If not successful, then we will rent a steamer to try to remove as much as possible. It cannot exceed \$50. Cathy seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

### **Treasurer Report by Joyce Heitmiller-**

- Previous balance-\$10,731.56
- Concession income-\$8,371.93
- Total deposits-\$9,778.93
- Total expenses-\$3,397.65
- Balance on hand-\$17,112.84

Kelli has spoken with the Dodge dealer regarding the money that was raised last year. Per the dealer she spoke with, that check was just sent out.

Joyce mentioned that the Creekview Booster check was not received. She is stopping that check and re-issuing a new check.

Couple of the checks we received and deposited have been returned insufficient.

Joyce mentioned that there was a \$100 adjustment on the statement. Called bank and they said that it was due to an August deposit made. Looking into for further information.

Roughly there is about \$10,000 available in funds not designated to be used for other things. We still owe approximately \$3,000 for under armour and there is \$4,000 in donations set aside for the trailer expense.

Marla suggested opening another account with a small balance that earns interest, like a money market or certificate of deposit. Joyce said she would look into this.

Have received a \$60 check from the magazine fundraiser.
