### **Band Directors Report by John Canfield-**

Depending on number of tickets sold, there will be a formal dance this Friday. Charles Ulrich and Cathy Haynes have volunteered to sell tickets at the concert Thursday.

This Saturday the winter guard will perform in a contest at The Colony.

New York City has been chosen as the big trip for 2008. This trip will be from the Tuesday (during spring break) thru the following Saturday. The following is more information on the trip.

- The cost will be \$1,000 per person wishing to attend. This price is based on 4-person occupancy and does include chaperones as well.
- Any parent that wishes to attend will be considered a chaperone.
- The trip will include 1 Broadway show with an option for a 2<sup>nd</sup> show. Those that choose not to do the 2<sup>nd</sup> show will have another option available to them. Also this includes the cost of almost every meal.
- The students will give a concert at one of the major children's hospital.
- Some of the sites will include The Empire State Building, Macy's, and Ground Zero.
- Will kickoff and promote the trip either by the end this month or first of next month.
- Travel company providing for this trip will take care of arrangements and payments.
