- Scratch and Win cards-Friends, family, etc, scratch off to determine donation amount. Total donation amount per card is \$100. Amounts of donations will vary from .50 cents to \$3.00. For scratching off they get a \$100 coupon. Cards costs \$20 each and has a minimum order amount.

- Taser donations- If the kids can raise \$10,000 then Mr. Canfield said that he will get tasered by a police taser. A Saginaw police officer has volunteered to perform the tasing. Along that lines, Mr. Pearson has said that he will get tasered if the students earn an additional \$5,000 on top of what they earn for Mr. Canfield.
