

General Band Booster Board Meeting September 5, 2006

Kelli Dougher-

Kelli called the meeting to session. Thanked the parents for coming and for their support.

Introduced the officers for this school year.

Band Directors Report by John Canfield-

Presented and described this year half time show “Decent into Madness”.

Showed the display of the portraits of from last year. These were the pictures of Saginaw High School’s first band.

Mr. Canfield let the parents know that any support loading the instruments before and after the games is very much appreciated.

Notified parents that we are looking for a few parents that have CDL licenses. That way we would be able to rent a larger truck to take the instruments for away games.

Minutes by Richelle Barnaby-

Kelli notified the parents that the minutes are available online. Did not have the previous meeting minutes. So Richelle will read those minutes the next meeting.

Fund Raising by Philip Hinkle-

- Introduced a Coca-Cola fundraiser. This is selling 20oz bottled Coke products for \$17 a case. The band would receive \$5 per case sold.
- Introduced a *Dominos Pizza* night. This is where we would hand out flyers printed by Dominos. Each flyer received for that night specified, the band booster would receive \$1. Date TBA.
- Notified parents that some of the local restaurants will be providing meals prior to the home games.
- Notified parents that the Sonic on Western Center Blvd will be offering discounts to persons who purchase from them after Friday night Football games. Must bring ticket stub with them to receive a discount. Philip mentioned but was not sure that the discount would be 20% off.
- Introduced doing a concession stand out at Texas Motor Speedway during a race. Would receive part of the proceeds earned at that concession that day.

- Introduced Mr. Canfield camping out on Sam Pack's Five Star Ford next summer. He will receive \$100 per auto sold. Another idea tied in with this is to have the students get pledges for each day Mr. Canfield camps out.
- Possibly looking to do a Classic Car Show some time next year around April or May.
- Explained to parents why we have fundraisers. Explained that those funds help keep the cost down from the students, offer scholarships, enable us to have funds to go to contest and competitions, etc.
- Asked parents if they know of any company or employer that would like to help sponsor the band to let us know.

Concessions by Sandra Barnes-

- Always need assistance with running the stand on game nights.
- Will be selling concession cards at the concession stand. This is a card that students can purchase to use at the concession stands instead of cash.
- Will be selling the *Rough Rider* cards for \$5.00. Only valid thru the end of December.
